Terms and Conditions

1. The grant shall be used solely for the purposes as outlined in the application.
2. Any funds unused by this specific project shall be returned to the Thames North Youth and Children's Work Committee.
3. Each application must include a budget for the project detailing expenditure and proposed income.
4. Accounts detailing the expenditure of the funds shall be made available to the Youth and Children's Work Committee.
5. Any changes to the proposed expenditure shall be cleared with the officers of the Youth and Children's work Committee in advance through the Committee Secretary.
6. On completion of the project or following expenditure of funds a report shall be provided to the Youth and Children's Work committee detailing the outcomes of the work.

Criteria

The overall purpose of the grants is to encourage new work and to enhance mission amongst children and young people. Grants are available for groups or churches and to individual young people for appropriate development and training opportunities.

Grants shall not exceed £500 per project, group or activity per year (Jan-Dec).

Grants to individuals shall not exceed £100 per person in any year (Jan-Dec)

Grants will not normally be given for capital expenditure.

Working within their limited funds the committee will give preference to grants for new work wherever possible.

Grant applications will be considered at the Youth & Children's Work committee.
