Each session will include:

- a 40 minute ‘taste and try’ class to give you an idea of content, level and study skills required.
- the opportunity to hear from those responsible for the degree as well as some of the students currently taking the course.
- discussion of the practical arrangements and the cost and sources of funding.

The **MA in Pastoral Theology** comprises 4 taught modules and a 15,000 word dissertation. Of the taught modules, *Pastoral Theology in History and Practice* is compulsory and is normally taken first. Students may replace one of the remaining 3 taught modules by a Placement Module, which may be taken either independently of or closely linked to present work in ministry.

**Criteria for admission** are evidence of ability to work at post-graduate level (candidates do not have to be graduates), some prior learning in theology, and current involvement in Christian ministry (paid, unpaid, lay, ordained, part or full time).

The MA may be taken **part or full time**. In Chelmsford the course is run on a part-time basis monthly on Saturdays (6 x 4-hour sessions). It is possible to take only 2 taught modules and receive a **Postgraduate Certificate** or 4 taught modules for a **Postgraduate Diploma**.

The Cathedral Learning Centre is part of the Cathedral Office premises at Chelmsford. Access is through the archway to the left of the Diocesan Office, Guy Harlings, 53 New Street Chelmsford CM1 1AT. Go through the courtyard to the next archway and the Cathedral Office is the glass-panelled door on your left. The Learning Centre is adjacent, through the arch towards the garden, and has its own door on the left, clearly labelled. Parking is available at the end of Waterloo Lane and (by arrangement) in the Diocesan Car Park off Waterloo Lane.
