Can anyone in CRN, anywhere, respond to this request received just now from Theresa, the referrals manager of Medical Justice, the small and sparky NGO doing independent medical reports for torture victims in asylum detention....?

This is an ex asylum detainee....If he was seen by a Medical Justice doctor and documented as a torture victim, then re-detention is probably going to do his head in, and it would make alternative accomodation extra urgent.....

Offers from anywhere in Britain are welcome.....we'll deal with the finding of solicitors and travel later..... More info if and when needed.....

Dear all,

Would any of you be able to host a Sudanese asylum seeker for a while or point me to anywhere who might be able to help? It's a Sudanese man who fled to the UK 4 years ago after being imprisoned and tortured in Sudan. His recent fresh claim was refused and he will have to move out from his NASS accommodation tomorrow.

He will need to find a new solicitor to help him submit a JR and only then he will be able to apply for NASS support again.

He is staying in Hull at the moment but is willing to come go anywhere in the UK where someone might be able to help.

I'd be grateful for any suggestions.
